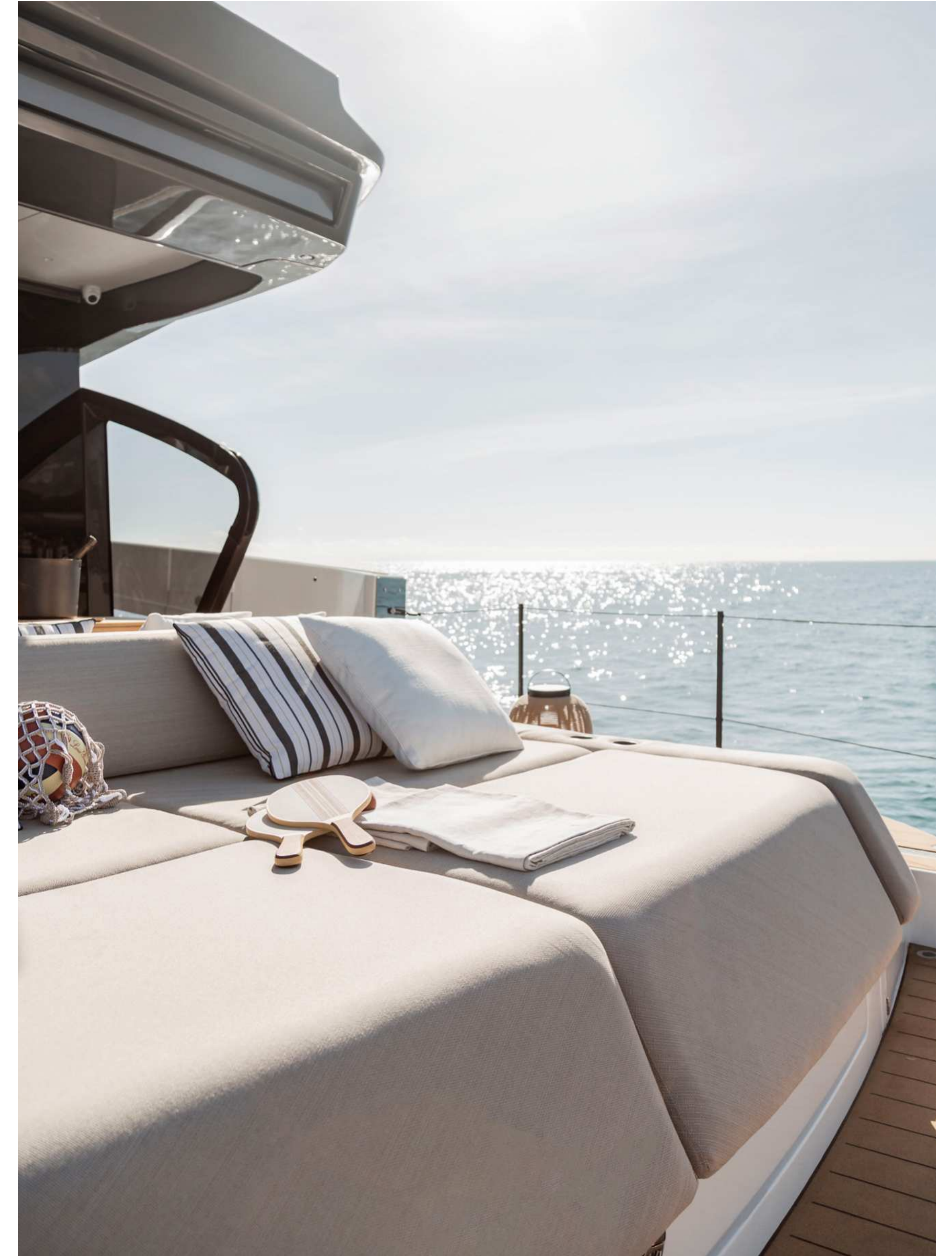


BEAUTY IS EXPRESSED THROUGH THE SIMPLICITY OF FORM

A DESIGN PHILOSOPHY BASED ON WELL-BEING

A new lifestyle paradigm based on wellbeing. In their interior design for the Seadeck Series, Matteo Thun & Antonio Rodriguez, making their debut in the world of yachting, draw on the conscious philosophy that is the distinctive feature of their approach to architecture. The goals are twofold: to highlight the essence of a space where it's easier to feel good, to redefine the concept of luxury based on well-being and the choice of gentle materials.





The collaboration of the creative duo Thun&Rodriguez with Azimut is consciously centered on clearly defined, shared values: a simple design language that opens up the core of the space, and the use of natural or recycled materials to ensure a conscious utilization of the earth's resources. It is through this methodology that they have imbued the interiors of the Seadeck 6 with beauty that stands the test of time, contributing to her sustainability in a world of passing trends.

[One of the most innovative solutions is the kitchen worktop made of Lapitec. This sintered stone is composed of 100% natural, oil-free minerals. Thanks to Lapitec, it was possible to maintain the boat's design philosophy in the kitchen area, with the hob seamlessly concealed under a beautiful surface.]

LIGHT AND SHADOW

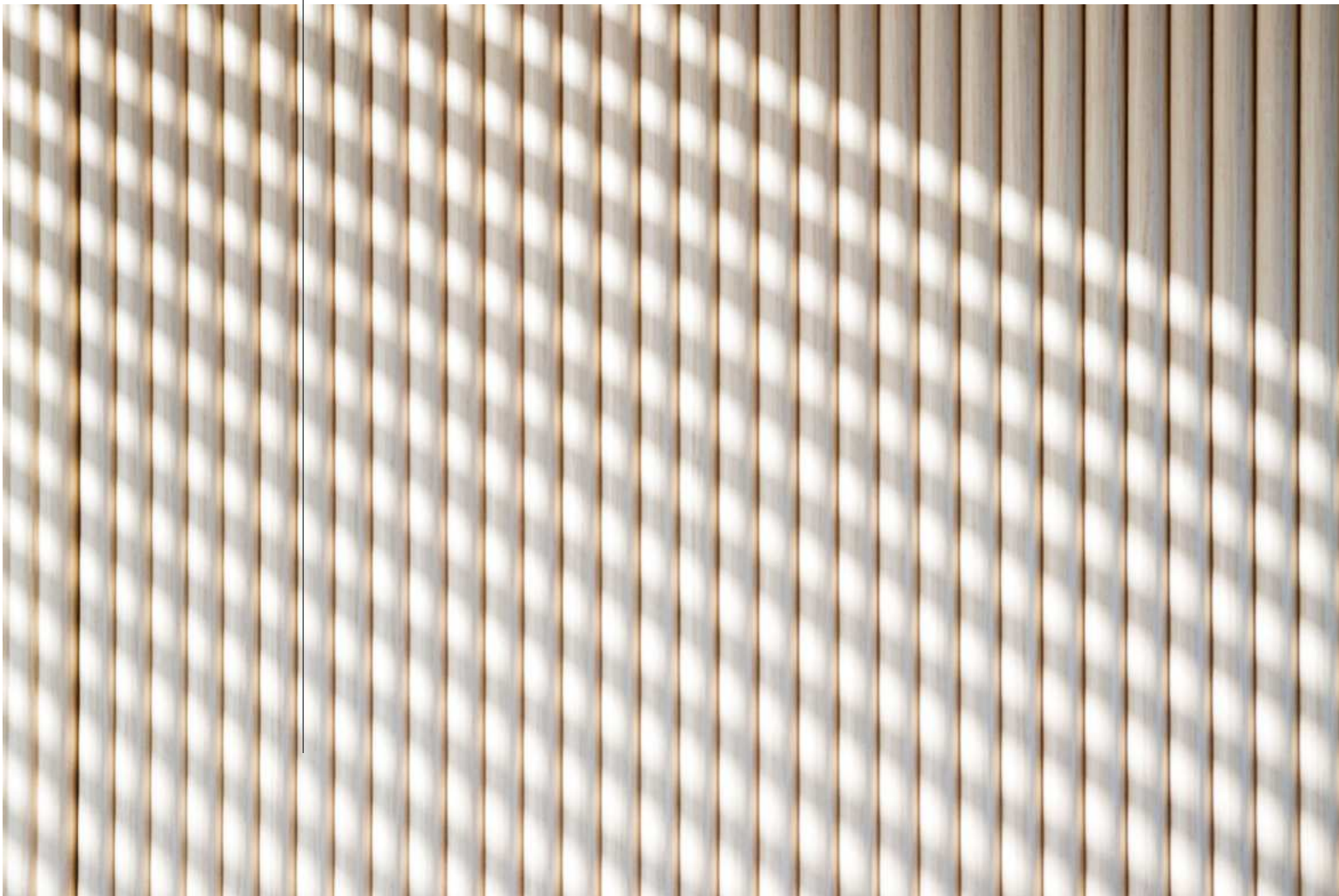
Warm, intimate light plays a fundamental role in the design, and to create an original interpretation of light and shadow the architects chose to use oak ribbing wood, a material that not only donates surface intensity but also contributes to the durability of the boat because it doesn't scratch and lives longer.





[The brise soleil on the ceiling has the same language as the ribbing, creating patterns of light and shadow, and consequently a sense of tranquility also accentuated by the caustic patterns of the sea.]

A SILENT DESIGN

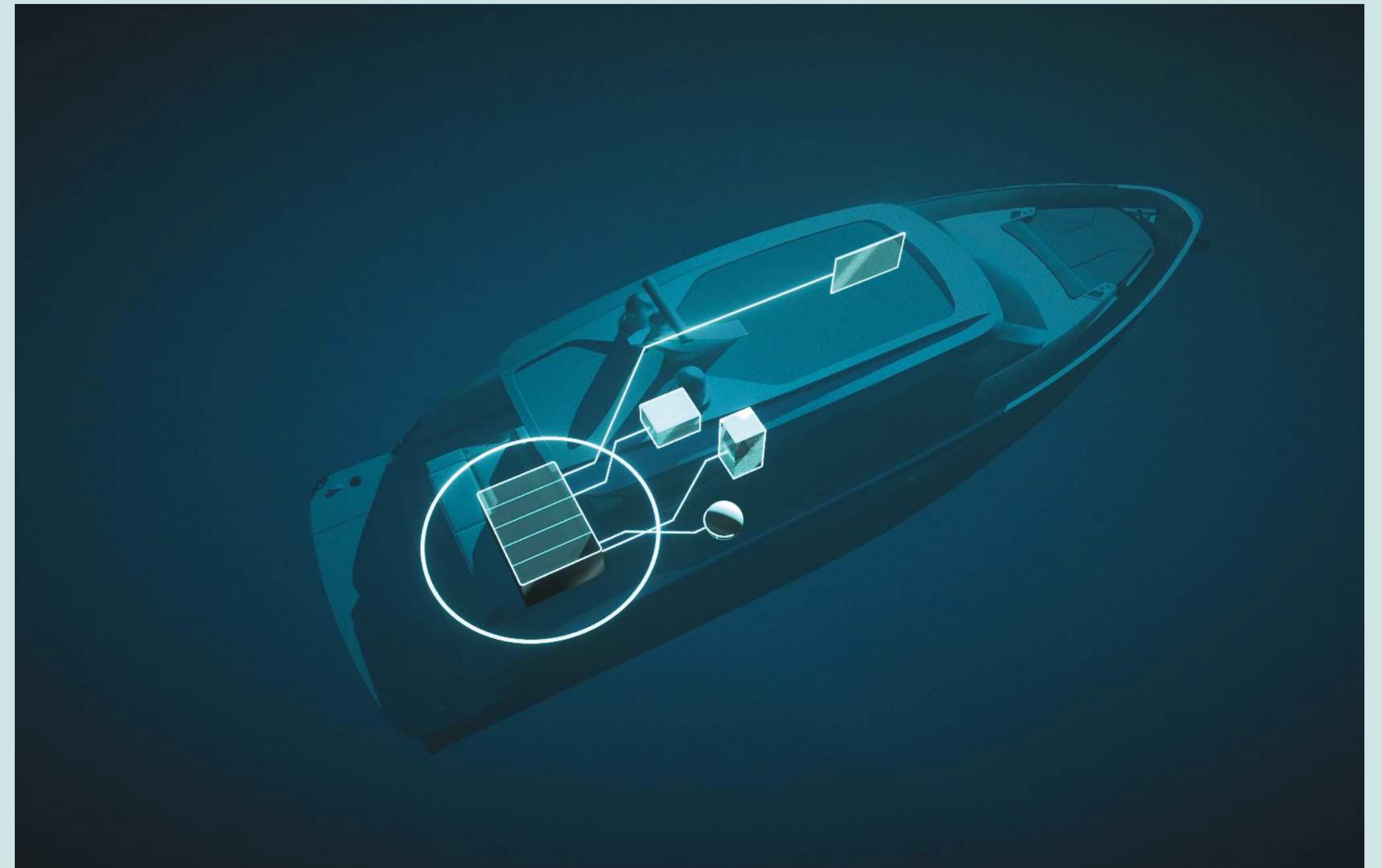

HER MAIN TECHNICAL FEATURES

The beauty of the Seadeck 6 is not solely a matter of exterior and interior design elements that combine to perfectly play out Azimut's essence. Her beauty is also about discovering the technological advancements and special components that contribute to making her truly unique and highly innovative.

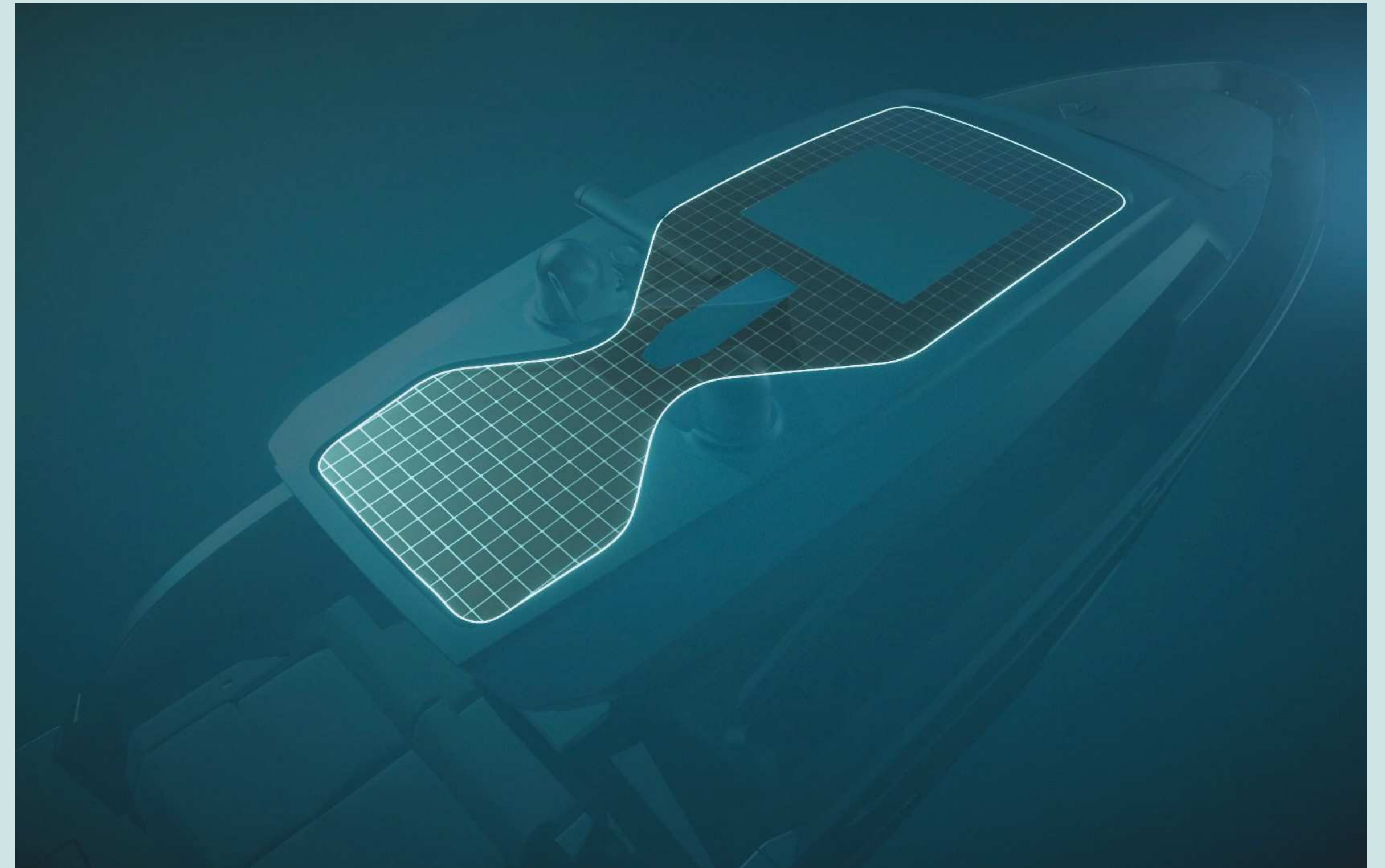
MILD HYBRID ZERO EMISSION HOTEL MODE

Thanks to a 42 kW/h lithium-ion battery pack, which allows the boat to be used in zero-emission hotel mode for up to 4 hours during the day and 8 hours at night, and thanks to an alternator connected to one of the heat engines, that recharges the batteries while sailing, it is now finally possible to enjoy the full Seadeck 6 experience without noise, vibrations and generator emissions. Daily activities will be more pleasant and nighttime relaxation more peaceful.



RENEWABLE ENERGY

The Seadeck 6 can be equipped with 10 square meters solar panels installed on the deckhouse, resulting in a total power of 1410Wp. The energy generated by the solar panels contributes to charging the battery pack, lowering CO₂ emissions even further.



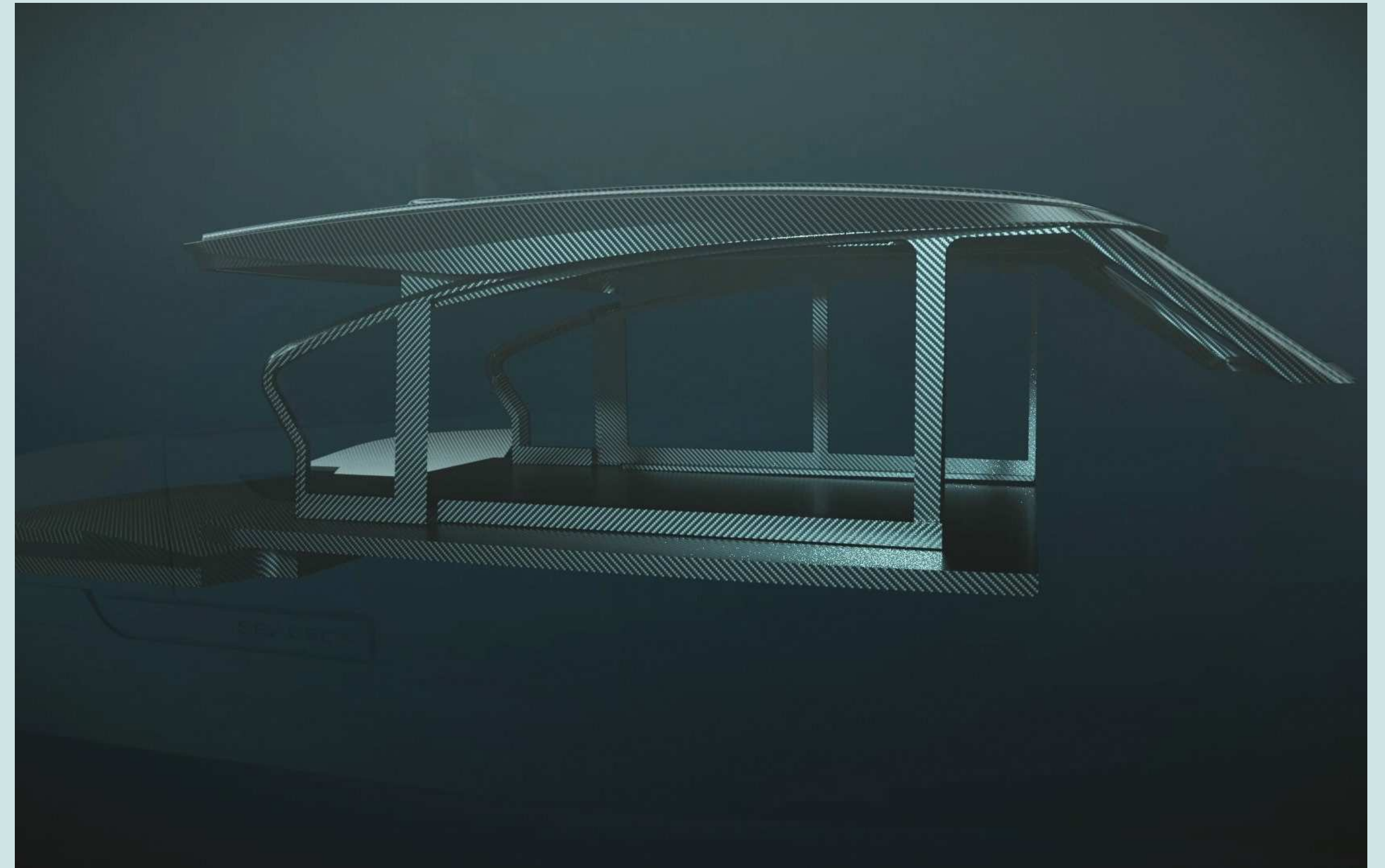
ADVANCED HULL DESIGN

The collaboration between NAMES and Azimut's R&D Department pushes the forefront of innovation, designing customized hulls for each Series with sector's most sophisticated methodology. In comparison with standard planing hulls optimized for POD propulsion, the hull of the Seadeck 6 is wider at the stern and more streamlined at the bow, allowing it to begin hydroplaning and therefore reducing drag at lower speeds. This advanced solution broadens the speed range at which the Seadeck 6 can navigate at peak efficiency.



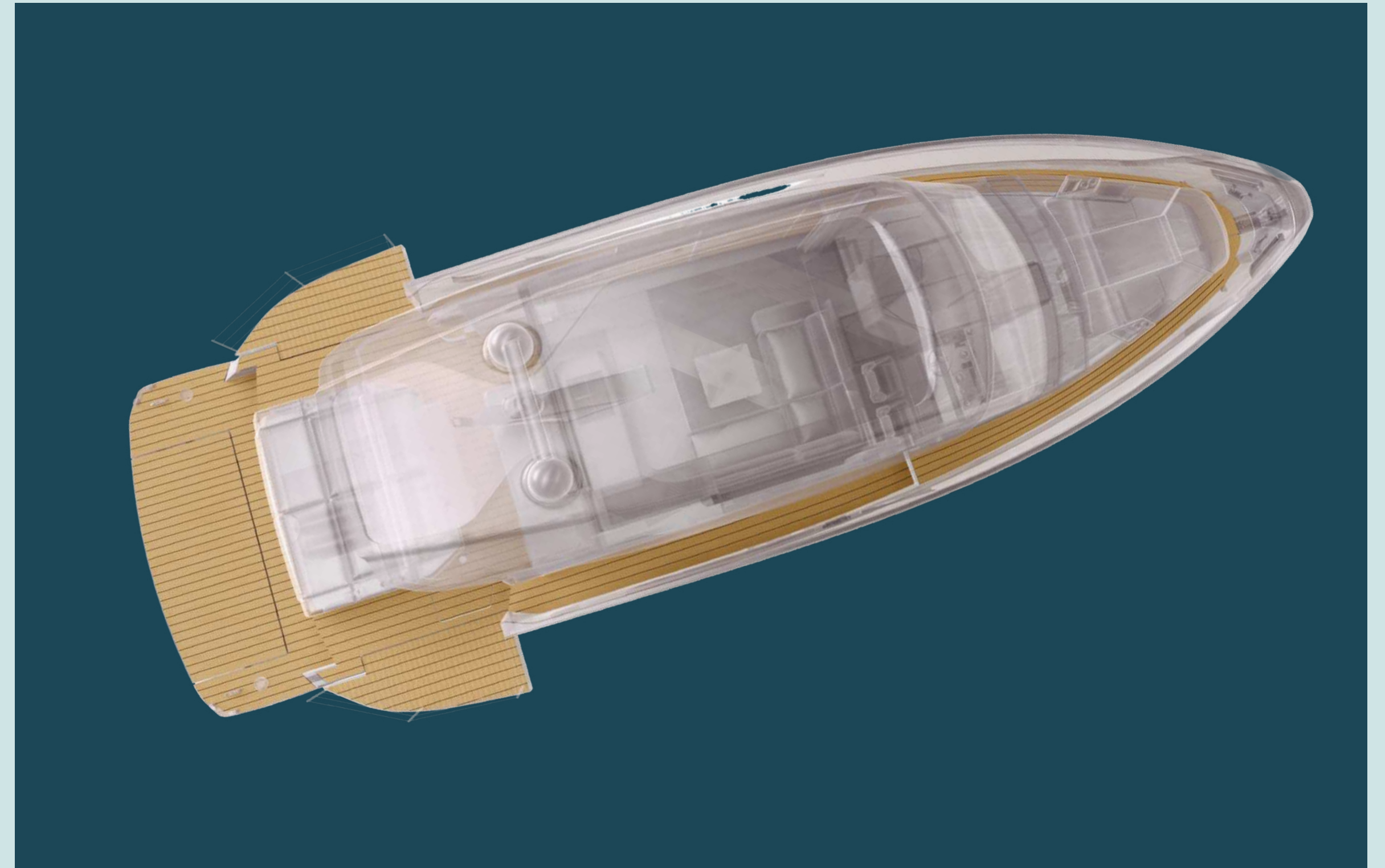
CARBON TECH GENERATION

Azimut's pioneering use of carbon fiber extends beyond pure performance. For the first time ever, up to 40% of the Seadeck 6's surface is laminated with carbon fiber, which lightens those parts by up to 30%, allowing for an unparalleled optimization of consumption and CO₂ emissions.



CORK DECKING

The Seadeck 6 features an innovative decking solution made entirely of cork, a sustainable material which, unlike traditional teak, can be harvested without damaging the tree and regrows over time. Cork's mechanical properties perfectly fit the Seadeck philosophy, with a combination of natural texture, heat and noise insulation, and light weight (40% less than teak).



ECO CONSCIOUS BY NATURE

HONEY OAK

This essence is FSC certified. It is wood from responsibly managed forests and in accordance with rigorous environmental, social and economic standards.

ECO-LEATHER

The Eco-Leathers are made of recycled polyester.

PET AND ECONYL

The PET carpet is made of 100% recycled PET.

The Econyl carpet is obtained from regenerated nylon which gives the possibility of being recycled an indefinite number of times.

LAPITEC

The kitchen top is made of ecological Lapitec. It does not release any substance into the environment in which it is placed and the life cycle of the product is reversible: the material can be destroyed and pulverized – returning raw material – and reused to restart the production process.

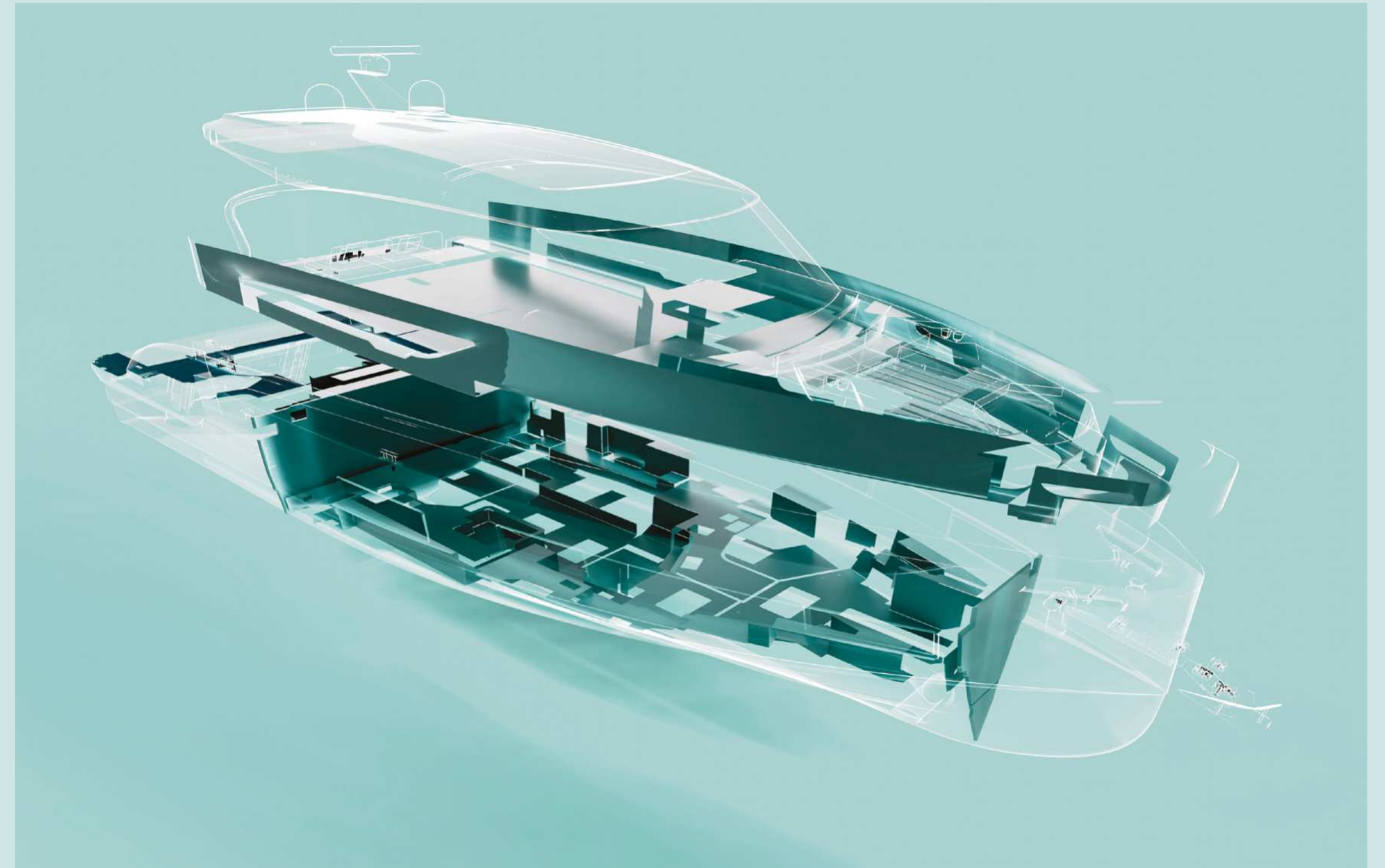
LIBECCIO

Outdoor cushions are made of recycled UV polyester.



RECYCLED PET

For the first time, Azimut has committed to using PET to replace PVC, reducing the amount of new plastic needed. PET, a recycled material that comes from plastic bottles, makes up 30% of the total structure of Seadeck yachts. It is infused into all the bulkheads, floors and 75% of the inner deck equivalent to 15,000 plastic bottles recycled for each boat produced.



RINA GREEN PLUS CERTIFICATION

Persistent investment in the research and implementation of advanced technologies and sustainable materials has allowed the Seadeck Series to be the shipyard's first to obtain the RINA GREEN PLUS PLATINUM certification for its environmental performance, even in its standard configuration.

A SAFE AND HEALTHY WORK ENVIRONMENT

The forerunning shipyard of Avigliana was the first of the company's Italian shipyards to obtain the ISO 45001 certification in 2011, attesting its rigorous abidance to all occupational health and safety requirements. Recognized as the most technologically-advanced shipyard in Europe, it has also led the nautical sector revolution in terms of being among the earliest adopters of the vacuum infusion process to drive resin into a laminate, avoiding styrene emissions and therefore guaranteeing its precious workers a healthier setting.

As of 2013, all the other Italian production sites have adapted to meet the necessary requirements to obtain the ISO 45001 certification.
